The Garmon Corporation requested recertification of their facility to comply with the National Animal Supplement Council (NASC) primary requirements and continued permission to use the NASC Quality Seal. The recertification audit was conducted in two parts: an on-site inspection to verify compliance with NASC Good Manufacturing Practices (cGMPs) and an off-site inspection of labels, extensions of labeling and the NASC Adverse Event Reporting System (NAERS).

Following the audit, a Recertification Audit Observation Report was prepared and sent to The Garmon Corporation. These observations were communicated in writing and required documentation of corrective action before continued use of the NASC Seal could be authorized. Final authorization to use the NASC Quality Seal on products must be received in writing. Additionally, as this is not a full compliance audit, the company agrees to maintain and uphold the standards defined by our organization as set forth in the NASC cGMPs determined by the NASC Board of Directors.

Based on the audit of The Garmon Corporation, a manufacturer, re-packager and distributor of feed supplements and non-feed products for companion animals, several observations were noted; however, all deficiencies were corrected during the NASC audit process. All corrective actions have been taken, supporting documentation received and reviewed, and corrections to NAERS noted.

After review, I am pleased to award The Garmon Corporation a 2-year NASC Certification. They have fully and successfully followed the guidelines under the NASC Audit certification program and have demonstrated a clear understanding of the requirements to use the NASC Quality Seal.

## These are:

- 1. The Garmon Corporation has a Quality Control Manual and SOPs in place which meet the requirements defined in the NASC cGMPs.
- 2. The Garmon Corporation is complying with NASC Labeling Guidelines.
- 3. The Garmon Corporation has demonstrated a substantial level of understanding as to allowable claims and is including recommendations of the Scientific Advisory Committee on products containing ingredients where additional information is required.
- 4. The Garmon Corporation is using the NASC Adverse Event Reporting System (NAERS) and complies with this requirement.
