On July 20, 2022, the Idaho State Department of Agriculture announced:

*“Effective November 1, 2022, ISDA will be inspecting for hemp and hemp-derived animal feeds and remedies. These products are not legal in Idaho, and if found on or after November 1, 2022, will be subject to a stop sale and further action from the department.”*

This action has been initiated despite:

- These products being on the market with no action taken for over 5 years
- No significant issues where negative effects on animal health have been reported

This action:

- May result in job losses for people employed in Idaho
- Will cause significant economic impact to Idaho-based businesses, both large and small
- Will likely result in harm to animals because owners will turn to human products or products containing THC

without such drastic action with far-reaching consequences!**
